Chancepixies Waggy Walk February 19th Guidelines and Disclaimer

Thank you so much for taking part in this event for Chancepixies. The dogs really appreciate your support! Please can you read and then sign the form below before we start.

All participants take part in events entirely at their own risk. Chancepixies shall not be liable for any accidents, injury, loss or damage sustained as a consequence of participation in any event organised by Chancepixies. Any participant, who has any doubts about their fitness or ability to take part, should consult their G.P. or a suitably qualified health professional before considering participation.

The walk is 3-4 miles long and goes across farmland and along minor roads. All walkers must keep their dogs on leads, clean up after their dogs using poo bags, provide enough water for themselves and their dogs and be physically fit enough to complete the distance. Walkers must ensure their dogs are under control at all times. This walk is on public footpaths which may be uneven so appropriate footwear must be worn – the walk is not suitable for child buggies and mobility scooters as there will be a few stiles to climb over! It may rain so waterproofs and warm clothing are suggested. All walkers must follow instructions given by the Chancepixies volunteers and when on the minor roads must walk in single file facing any oncoming traffic.

We are aiming to walk as a group at a medium pace, please try to keep together. It will be more fun! There will be a lead walker and a tail end walker. Both will have mobile phones. If there is a problem please notify either walker so help can be summoned if needed.

All walkers are asked to register on arrival and when they return from the walk. This is to ensure walkers safety. Please ensure all children under the age of 16 are accompanied by a responsible adult. Chancepixies cannot assume responsibility for lone children.

There will be Chancepixies dogs walking with the group. If you are walking one of the Chancepixies dogs please ensure you are with one of our Chancepixies volunteers. These dogs have been carefully selected for their temperament with people and will be fun to walk but Chancepixies cannot be held responsible if you are bitten by one of the dogs. You are walking them entirely at your own risk. Please also abide by the guidelines set out above and have fun! These dogs really appreciate your time and are looking forward to having some time out of the kennels!
